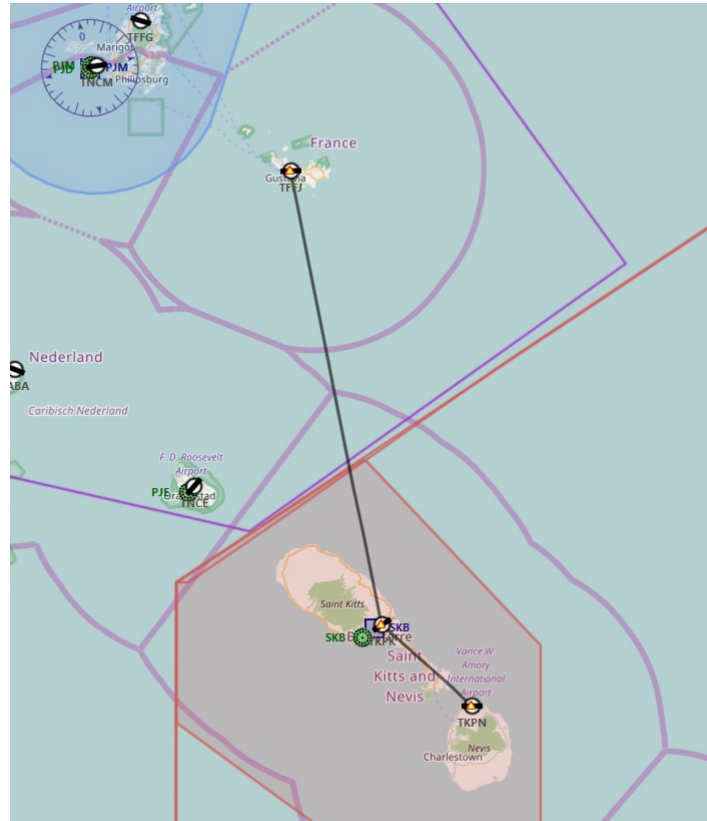

The Twelve Days of CiXmas

On the Fifth Day of CiXmas.....



.....we shall have a fairly easy day. We shall be saying a sad farewell to 'St Barts' as we depart and head south for Bradshaw International airport on the island of St Kitts. After a brief stopover here to exchange passengers & some cargo – probably the mail – we are off again as we make for Vance Winkworth Amory on the island of Nevis.

The airport was previously known as Bambooshay Airport, then Newcastle Airport. It was renamed in 2002 after the Premier of Nevis, Vance Amory, following the completion of a new, more modern terminal, a new control tower, and an extension to the runway. The airport is available to most aircraft, being an international airport. We shall be spending the night here before heading off to Antigua & Barbuda in the morning.

The Route

Leg 1	TFFJ (St Barthelmy) to TKPK (Bradshaw International)	36 nms
Leg 2	TKPK (Bradshaw International) to TKPN (Vance Winkworth Amory)	10 nms

This days flying is a mere 46 nms and flying time at 140 kts should be a breeze at 20 minutes. But you know the drill, with all the necessary actions that need to be undertaken, you should perhaps schedule at least one hour for today's trip.
