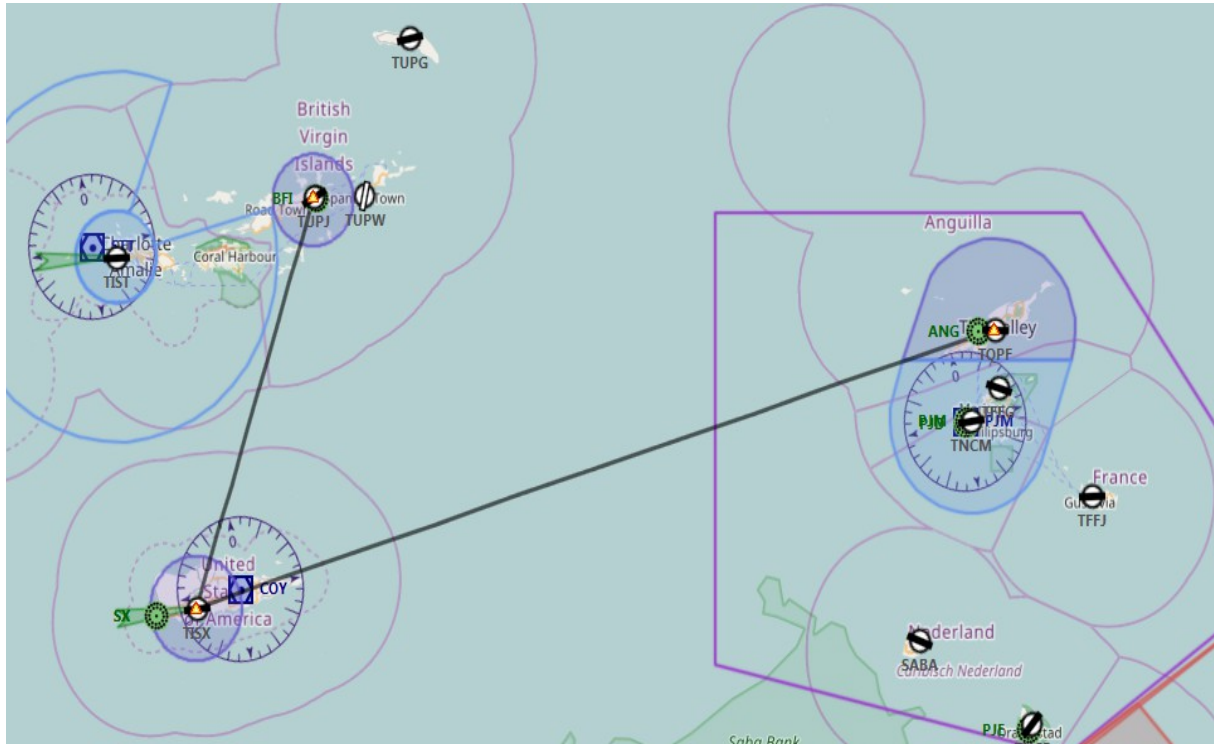

The Twelve Days of CiXmas

On the Second Day of CiXmas.....



....we rise up bright & early after an enjoyable stop-over in a posh hotel and wend our way to the airport. We have two trips today, the first of which is a short hop over to Henry E. Rohlsen airport. From there we have a longer trip over water to Wallblake air.strip, where we shall spend the night. The Clayton J. Lloyd International Airport (formerly known as the Anguilla Wallblake Airport) is a small international airport located on the island of Anguilla, a British Overseas Territory in the Caribbean. It is located very close to The Valley, the island's capital. It has a small terminal with no jetways and is the only airport in Anguilla.

The airport became known as the "Clayton J. Lloyd International Airport" on 4 July 2010. Its namesake was the first Anguillian aviator and founded the first Anguillian air service, Air Anguilla, which was later renamed Valley Air Service.

The Route

Leg 1	TUPJ (Terrance B. Lettsome) to TISX (Henry E. Rohlsen)	47 nms
Leg 2	TISX (Henry E. Rohlsen) to TQPF (Wallblake)	104 nms

This days flying is 151 nms and flying time at 140 kts should be around 65 minutes. However, with the turnaround, re-filing of flight plan and other necessary actions, you should plan for the day's trips to take about 1½ hours.
