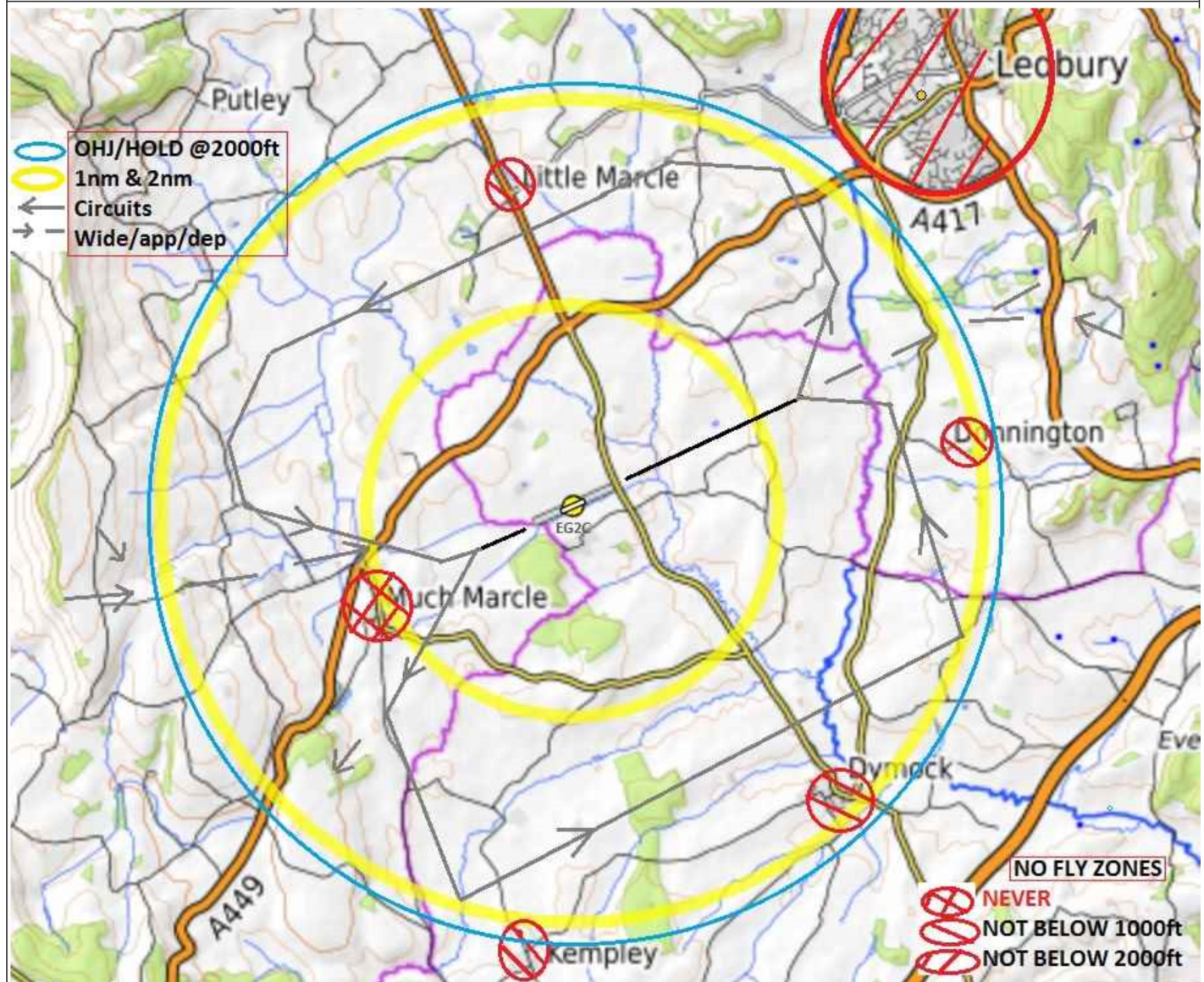
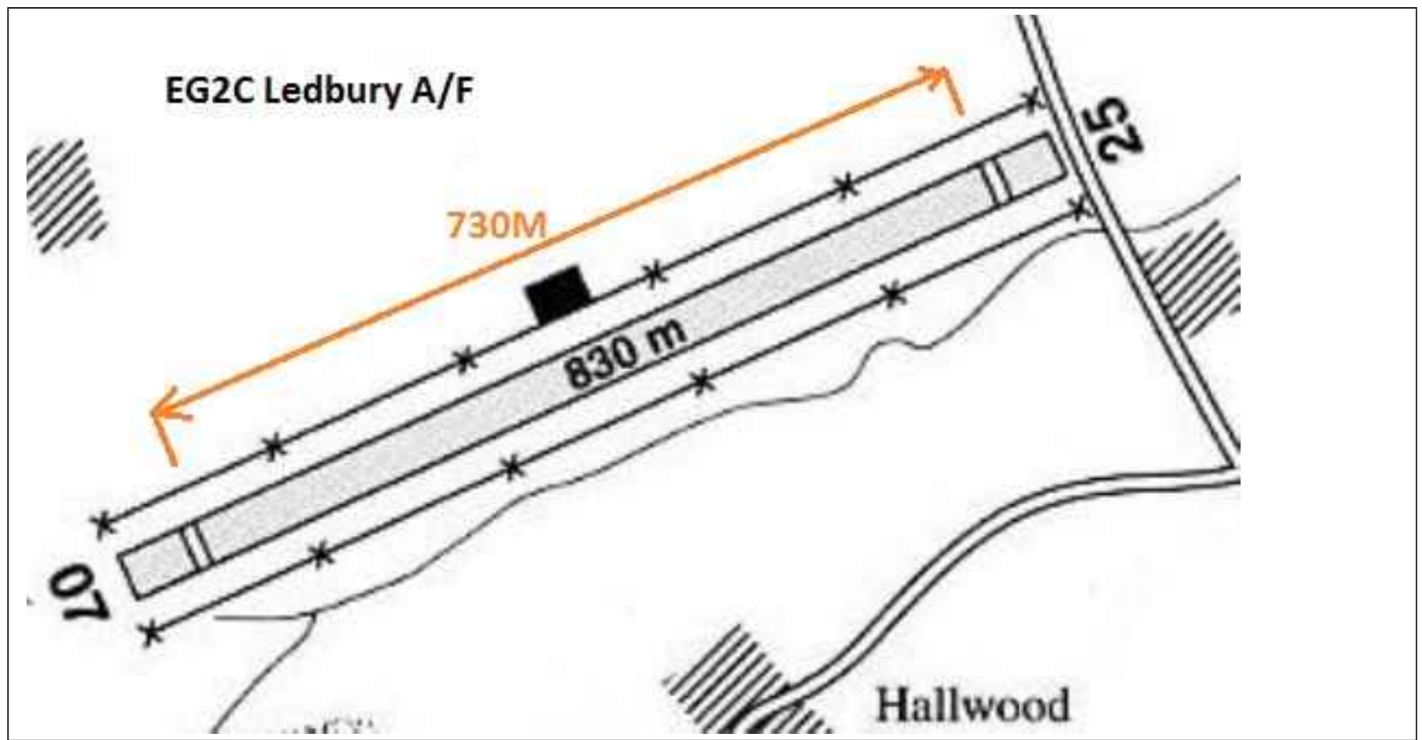

HELICOPTER OPERATIONS	Same as Fixed Wing. EXERCISE EXTREAM CAUTION. PARKING is VERY limited, NO A/C parking OUTSIDE of boundary fence. If < 3 x rotor diameter available. YOUR responsibility.					
SPECIAL RULES	Runway 25: 10° LEFT after T/O to avoid Much Marcle; avoid Dymock, Kempley and Little Marcle. JOIN OVERHEAD; 1. to assess traffic (ALL A?C must backtrack). 2. Is there room to park?					
REMARKS	<p>This is a challenging A/F for the un-prepared! Almost hidden by trees from the South.</p> <p>VERY NARROW runway boundary - you will need to be able to turn with one wheel locked.</p> <p>VERY limited parking - 6 A/C would be difficult, even with 2 or 3 in the hangers.</p> <p>It is recommended you practice on EGBJ 18/36.</p> <p>You need to be able to stop on the runway with at least 2 c/l dashes ahead of you.</p> <p>THEN you need to be able to turn and backtrack within the confines of the ASPHALT.</p> <p>LOW WING A/C are NOT recommended unless you are VERY competent and confident with this exercise. Fences ar not kind to low set wings!</p>
